SUMMER COURSES

SPRING SEMESTER COURSES

Upper School (Jr. High, High School) courses: 16 weeks, 32 classes*, classes meeting twice per week

- Orientation sessions**: week of January 16
- Start date: Monday, January 23
- End date: Friday, May 19

HOLIDAYS (NO CLASSES):

- Monday, November 21–Friday, November 25 (Thanksgiving)
- Monday, December 19–Friday, January 6 (Christmas and New Year's)
- Monday, April 10–Friday, April 14 (Holy Week/Easter)

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Week of August 29: orientation sessions** for fall semester courses and yearlong courses
- September 6: first day of fall semester courses and yearlong courses
- November 21–25: Thanksgiving holiday (no classes)
- December 19–January 6: Christmas and New Year's holidays (no classes)
- Week of January 16: orientation sessions** for spring semester courses
- January 20: last day of fall semester courses

- January 23: first day of Spring Semester Courses
