- Embark on a four-year journey through the Great Conversation, reading the most influential works that have shaped human thought, and discussing these books in small, intensive Socratic seminars.
- Join a Welcoming Community of motivated peers who share a genuine love for learning, and distinguished professors who are dedicated to both intellectual and spiritual formation.
- Receive a world-class education that is Rooted In Christ. We seek to educate the

whole person, so our students will be transformed by the renewing of their minds and better able to discern God's will for their lives (Romans 12:1-2).



## The William Penn Honors Program: an Antidote to the Superficiality of our Age

- Rather than fleeting connections, this program offers face-to-face learning in small seminar settings and authentic community with professors and peers.
- Rather than mere information, this program provides intellectual, spiritual and moral formation. Honors students gain knowledge as well as the discernment to rightly use it.
- Rather than chasing trends, this program immerses students in wisdom that endures, using texts that have stood the test of time and remain transformative in our day.
- Rather than shallow faith that is easily lost, this program cultivates deep-rooted Christian faith that is shaped by Scripture, grounded in history, and nourished by prayer.



### How We Do It

George Fox offers bachelor's degrees in <u>more than 40 majors</u>, and the honors program works alongside most of them. The honors program replaces the regular general education requirements with an entirely separate curriculum (with the exception of math and science requirements).



Most admitted honors students come out of high school with a GPA of 3.7 or higher, an ACT composite of 27 or higher, an SAT (ERW+M) score of 1290 or higher, or a CLT of 84 or higher. If you meet at least one of these benchmarks and are a highly motivated student, we encourage you to apply.
